A service charge of 10% will be assessed. This includes entries sent online or post using a credit card or interac for payment.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- **ELIGIBILITY:** Purebred or mixed-breed dogs must be at least 6 months of age that:
 - (a) Are individually registered with the CKC (have a CKC registration number), or
 - (b) Have an Event Registration Number (ERN), or
 - (c) Have a Performance Event Number (PEN), or
 - (d) Are eligible for registration with the CKC, or
 - (e) Have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed, or
 - (f) Have a Canine Companion number (CCN) if it is a mixed-breed.

Dogs that are eligible for a CKC or ERN number but don't yet have one must have a Temporary Competition Number (TCN). These can be obtained free of charge online from the CKC. <u>TCN info</u>

The CKC has a tracking fee for non-members. Please refer to the information about this policy on the CKC website: Non-member participation fee

- ENTRY LIMIT: Trial is limited to 60 runs. If the trial fills, a waitlist will be kept @ https://forms.gle/riscVUJU787Mwfdw8

 Handlers may only enter 1 dog in the 3 components at each level. Dogs can only be
 - entered in Master components if they have already qualified at the Excellent level in that component. Day of trial entries will NOT be accepted at this event. There will be no move-ups at this trial.
- RUNNING ORDER: will be emailed to handlers one day before the match.
 A Running Order will be posted on site for hands free reference.
- ODOURS: Excellent: Wintergreen, Pine or Anise Master: Wintergreen, Pine, Anise or Clove
- **EQUIPMENT**: The dog may wear a buckle, snap or martingale collar and/or body harness in the ring. Collars/harnesses with tags may be worn in the ring. Harnesses may have the leash attached to the front clip or on the back. Electronic training and pinch collars are not allowed on the grounds.
- **REFUNDS**: Entry fees will not be refunded after February 1, 2023. In the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge or barred from competition by action of the Match Committee or the Canadian Kennel Club, or if it is impossible to open or complete the test, no refund of entry will be made.
- **BITCHES IN SEASON**: Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. If a bitch comes into season after entries have closed, the club will refund the entry fee providing the event secretary receives, on or before the event, a veterinarian's certificate declaring that the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial.
- **TEST SITE**: No indoor kenneling. This match will be run rain or shine. All dogs must be under control, on a leash except during the match where off leash searches are permitted. Flexi leads will not be allowed on the test site. Remember that this is a public park used by families. Clean up after yourself and your dog. Bathroom facilities are on site. A concession is available at Planet Ice within walking distance of the venue.
- REGULATIONS: It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules
 pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Printed copies of the CKC Scent

- **CKC REGULATION**: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Match Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- ROSETTES & PRIZES: A rosette will be awarded for all new titles. Only those dogs earning qualifying scores will receive flat ribbons.

By participating in these tests (as handler, spectator or in any other role) each participant agrees to assume all risk and hazards incidental to these tests and agrees to release and to save harmless and indemnify the Golden Retriever Club of British Columbia and its members, any volunteer and the owners of the property upon which the tests are held together with their officers, agents, employees and representatives from all claims, actions, cost expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to the person or property of the participant howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with the participants use or entry upon the property. It is understood that this agreement is binding upon the participants, his or her heirs, executors and assigns.
