The fee is in addition to each entry for each trial. See premium list for rules for ERN, PEN, Canine Companion, or miscellaneous class certification numbers required. Mixed and unrecognized breeds must have a CCN #.

Entries will be accepted on the day of the trial up to one hour prior to starting of judging ONLY IF SPACE IS AVAILABLE.

MAKE ALL CHEQUES/MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE TO PRINCE GEORGE KENNEL CLUB

In payment of entry fees, the tendering of NSF cheques shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. A collection fee of \$50.00 will be added to the amount of any returned cheque. Credit card payment will be accepted when accompanied by authorized VISA or MASTERCARD credit card number, expiry date and cardholder's name. 10% of total fee will be added for Credit Card/Interact on entries. Telephone entries are not accepted by the Show Secretary. Incomplete entries or entries received without fees, or entries received after the advertised closing date will not be accepted. There will be no refund on overpayments or duplicate entries.

US exhibitors, please purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds for the full amount of your entry. BEST OWNER-HANDLED DOG IN GROUP AND SHOW

The handler of the dog must be the owner of record. The owner must show the dog at all levels of competition. This competition is open to non-professionals only. Anyone who has handled dogs for which they have received any compensation in any capacity in the past 3 years is not eligible to participate.

There are no additional fees for this event. Participants need to pre-register the dogs must be entered in a regular conformation class.

TIME: Following Puppy in Group and Puppy in Show

Owner-Handled competition is an unofficial class. Participants do need to pre-register and will need to inform the ring steward following the breed judging that they are the owner. The handler of the dog must be the owner for the classes. Only owner-handled dogs that receive a Best of Breed ribbon are eligible to compete in the Best Owner Handled Dog in Group. The winner of Best Owner/Handler in breed may compete in Best Owner/Handler in Group unless the dog was already defeated at the Best in Group level, by another Best Owner/Handler dog. The winner of Best Owner/Handler in Group will compete in Best Owner/Handler in Show after the completion of Best Puppy in Show unless the dog was already defeated, at the Best in Show level, by another Best Owner/Handler dog that is entered in this competition



Classes will be divided by Sex: 4-6 month /6 - 9 months /9 - 12 months /12 - 18 months

VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES

July 21th, 2023 after Juvenile Sweeps

Judge: Roy Juliusson

Classes will be divided by Sex: 7 – 10 years of age/ 10 and over years of age

PRIZES

1 – 4 in each age class Ribbon (Flats)

FIRST of Each Class will compete for:

BEST in SWEEPS receives a Rosette and 35% of total entry fees collected BEST OF OPPOSITE in SWEEPS receives a Rosette and 20% of total entry fees collected Club retains 25% to defray costs

To enter Veterans sweepstakes the dog must be entered in one of the regular classes or for exhibition only on the same day. Spayed and neutered dogs may compete provided they are entered in exhibition only.

CONFORMATION CLASSES OFFERED:

The following Regular classes will be offered, divided by sex.

JUNIOR PUPPY - 6 months & under 9 months on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY- 9 months & under 12 months on the day of the show

<u>CANADIAN BRED</u> - for dogs born in Canada, Champions in any country excluded.

<u>12 – 18 MONTH CLASS</u> 12 months and under 18 months on the day of the show.

<u>BRED BY EXHIBITOR</u> - shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. <u>OPEN CLASS</u> - shall be for all Dogs.

<u>SPECIALS ONLY</u> - This class will NOT be divided by sex. A dog may be entered for "Specials Only" and such dog shall compete for Best of Breed award. If eligible it must compete for the award of Best of Opposite Sex. All awards the dog earned at the show will be cancelled if, at the time of closing of entries for the show, the dog was not registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or if the dog has not earned all the championship points required for championship status. The entry of a Listed Dog in this class is NOT allowed.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

<u>VETERAN CLASS</u> - In this optional class for All Breed Shows, dogs must be 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered. The awards for this class are: Best Male Veteran and Best Female Veteran Best Veteran in Breed Best Veteran in Group Best Veteran in Show A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Breed is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Group. A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Group is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Show.

<u>BABY PUPPY CLASS</u> – Dogs 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. The award for this class are: Best Baby Male and Best Baby Female Best Baby Puppy in Breed Best Baby Puppy in Group Best Baby Puppy in Show

EXHIBITION ONLY - Dogs entered in this class may not compete in the regular breed classes.

<u>ALTERED:</u> Altered will be divided Males and Females with a Best of Breed judged for each. The Best of Breed winner will go on to Best Altered in Group and Best Altered in Show. All dogs must be surgically altered to enter this show.

BRACE CLASS: This class shall be for two dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex)

PLEASE KEEP THE SHOW GROUNDS CLEAN! PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG!

OBEDIENCE:

- PRE-NOVICE shall be for any dog which has not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person.
- NOVICE "A" No licensed handler, no trainer, nor any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its CDX. Title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be canceled.
- NOVICE "B" Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person & shall be for pure-bred dogs of any breed which have not won the title of C.D. in Canada
- NOVICE "C" as per Obedience Trial Rules & Regulation
- <u>INTERMEDIATE NOVICE</u> as per Obedience Trial Rules & Regulation
- OPEN "HA"- The Open HA class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized
 - breed which has earned the title of C.D. but has not earned the title of C.D.X. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or member of their immediate families. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a U.D. title may not handle a dog in this class. Group exercises in Open HA are out of site as before in the original open classes.
- OPEN "18A" -The requirements are the same as Open HA and the same rules except the Long Sit is replaced with Change of Positions Exercises and the Long Down is replaced with a Group Sit-Walk around.
- OPEN "HB" The Open HB class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D. Dogs which have earned the title of C.D.X. or any higher titles may enter in the Open B class. A dog may also be entered in the Utility Class in the same trial. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter or handle more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 7 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercises. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will choose which of the six numbered routines is to be performed. This choice will not be disclosed to the exhibitors until it is posted at ring side at least 30 minutes before the start of the class. In future assignments, judges are required to alternate the six routines so that each set will be used approximately the same number of times. Group exercises in Open HB are out of site as before in the original open classes.
- OPEN 18B The requirements are the same as Open HB and the same rules apply except the addition of the new Change of Positions Exercises. As described in the Open HA and Open 18A classes
- UTILITY "A" For any purebred dog that has not earned the title of UD. No person who has earned a MOTCH title may handle dogs in this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner or a member of their immediate families. Exercises will be performed in the usual order.
- UTILITY "B" Exercises will be done in random order. Order will be posted approximately 30 minutes prior to judging.

Refer to Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations for further information.

All exhibitors must be familiar with Obedience Rules and Regulations effective: January 1, 2021.

The precincts of these trials are the rings and immediate area surrounding the rings of the show site at Prince George Agriplex and the area and rings in the Obedience Trial Barn. Only dogs entered are permitted within the precincts of the trial.

*There is limited crating pace for obedience competitors only in the Trial Barn.

No food will be permitted in the ring.

GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS

It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the Conformation Rule book are available from the CKC, 5397 Eglinton Avenue W Suite 101 Etobicoke ON, M9C 5K6

- 1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or the Show Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show.
- 3. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 4. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. The Show Superintendent shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the rules, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.
- 5. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds.
- 6. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. No ring shall be held up waiting for exhibitors or handlers. Exhibitors & Handlers with more than one dog shall have substitute handlers available so the judging will not be delayed. All start times are PACIFIC DAYLIGHT TIME.
- 7. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
- 8. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown at a show held under these rules until the dog has been examined by an official committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied by a fee of \$107.80 + GST (CKC member) or \$161.60 + GST (non-member) which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the examining committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned at a dog show in violation of this rule shall be canceled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.
- 9. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and for their equipment left at the Show Grounds.
- 10. For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of the exhibitors and spectators we insist upon keeping our grounds and buildings as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog BEFORE taking it to the Judging ring. Dogs are to be exercised in the designated areas only, not in the vicinity of the ring areas.
- 11. No entry fee will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
- 12. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
- 13. The Club has a zero tolerance of abuse of any description involving any person involved with these shows, including spectators.
- 14. The washrooms and shower facilities are strictly for human use by order of the Health Department. Offenders will be removed from the Grounds for the duration of the shows.

OTHER EXTRACTS FROM CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

SHOW OFFICIALS – SECTION 5.1.6

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.3

Entry forms received by the CKC, which are incomplete and/or contain incorrect information may result in awards being cancelled.

ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.5

An error in an age-specified class, the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

ENTRIES - SECTION 8.3.1

Every dog entered in a conformation show must be one of the following:

- a. registered with the CKC
- b. has an Event Registration Number
- c. eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- d. with the exception of Baby Puppy, if it belongs to a listed breed, it must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN)

REFUSAL OF ENTRIES – SECTION 8.6.2

A Club may refuse any entry form from an exhibitor known to have tendered a dishonored cheque or declined credit card unless entries are accompanied by cash, money order or certified cheque.

DISQUALIFICATIONS - SECTION 14.1.4

Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by the dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.

INDIGNITIES - SECTION 19.7

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

A description of all *Conformation*, *Obedience Classes* and *Rule and Regulations* can be found at www.ckc.ca

- 1. This is an LIMITED entry Conformation and Performance dog show.
- 2. DAY OF TRIAL ENTRIES are permitted at this show. MIXED BREEDS are allowed in performance events with CCN.
- 3. It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to INDIGNITIES. The Conformation Show or Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue. (19.7 CKC Conformation Show and 20.7 CKC Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations.)
- 4. ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER CLOSING DATE in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by an act of the event club or because it has been entered incorrectly, except as provided in 8 below. Nor will entry fees be refunded if due to riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the PGKC, that make it impossible to open or complete the show.
- 5. ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED WHEN A BITCH ENTERED INTO THE OBEDIENCE SHOW COMES IN TO SEASON within 10 days of the show. A veterinary letter certifying that the bitch came into season within 10 days prior to the show must be delivered to the Show Secretary prior to the commencement of that trial's judging.
- 6. NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE:
 - a. An annual non-member fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
 - b. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or pay the non-member fee.
 - c. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-members of the CKC.
- 9. The show Grounds will be OPEN at 1 p.m. on Thursday for exhibitors. Booths may be set up after 11 a.m. Thursday.
- 10. Generators can be run between 6:00 a.m. each morning to 10:00pm each night
- 11. Neither PGKC or Prince George Agriplex are responsible for any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors, patrons or Show ground property. Which includes all areas from the entry gates and including the field, and building of said events.
- 12. All EMPTY rings are to be kept free of dogs one hour before the show and during the show.
- 13. Entries will be ACKNOWLEDGED after the closing date. Judging schedule and receipts available online.
- 14. Dogs must be EXERCISED in designated areas only. You must clean up after your dog!
- 15. All dogs in the show building must either be REGISTERED in the show, "IN TRANSIT"
- 16. All entries must be CLEARLY filled out. The PGKC Show Secretary will not correct incorrect entries.
- 17. SIGNS advertising puppies or other services will not be permitted on the grounds.
- 18. PGKC has a ZERO tolerance of abuse of any description involving any person involved with PGKC Shows, including spectators.

CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

- 15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.
- 15.1.10 Permission shall be granted a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group.
- 15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.
- 15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges; (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN); (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.
- 15.1.13 The Board interprets the words "earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges" to mean: (a) Three (3) or more Winners awards at not less than three (3) different shows, under three (3) different judges at the breed level; (b) each of the three (3) judge's awards must be one or more championship points won at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing; (c) all points required for championship status may be earned at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Breed or group placing.

As of July 2021, the rules for awarding of Grand Champion and Grand Champion Excellent have changed. Please see CKC Conformation Rule 15.2 Grand Champion (GCH) & 15.3 Grand Champion Excellent (GCHEX) for details.



ZERO TOLERANCE – Any individual initiating bullying tactics at the Prince George Kennel Club Shows will be asked to leave the show grounds premises immediately and for the remainder of the event (no refunds). A report will be filed with CKC and the Disciplinary Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit. Including and not limited to suspension from attending the event for a specific period of time in the future, including permanently.

Definition of Bullying: Refers to a range of behaviors in which targeted individuals are repeatedly, and over time, treated in a mean, insulting or abusive way. Bullying can be initiated deliberately or unconsciously. The affected person may feel upset, afraid, isolated, or humiliated. The bully sometimes acts alone and sometimes as part of a group of people. Examples include:

- insulting a person's skills, looks, or habits
- spreading false or malicious rumors, gossip, or innuendo
- berating/belittling an individual
- unwarranted criticizing or ridiculing, especially in the presence of others
- giving insulting nicknames
- engaging in practical jokes that humiliate
- undermining or deliberately impeding a person's work
- physical gesturing that intimidates, offends, degrades, or humiliates
- mocking a person's accent, abilities or mannerisms
- yelling or shouting which intimidates, coerces, or belittles
- intruding on a participant's privacy by pestering, spying or stalking
- physically abusing or threatening abuse
- criticising a participant persistently
- constantly belittling a person's opinions.

This applies to interpersonal and electronic communications, such as email, Facebook, text messaging, Twitter and Instagram During Dates of the events.
