Valerie Walters, Ranbourne Reg'd

I have been involved with Labrador Retrievers since 1974. We purchased our first yellow female as a family member. Only weeks after we brought her home, we met a couple with an English Setter at our local corner store, we started chatting and they suggested that we come to one of their local kennel club meetings and possibly join.

With their guidance, we attended our first Sanction match and we were hooked. That same year we registered our kennel name with the CKC. Unfortunately, Kim, our first lab was not impressed with the dog show scene and she became a happy couch potato enjoying walks and swimming at the back of our property.

Our next Labrador came from Sally McCarthy of Shamrock Acres Kennels. He was a handsome yellow boy, but due to an injury, we were no able to show him and he was placed in a family home. We then purchased a yellow bitch from Jeanne Young of Balmoral Kennels in the USA. This was a great experience for me. She became Am. Can. Bda. Ch. Labradale's Jill of Balmoral. She was shown in Bermuda by our good friend Barbara partridge who was a handler. She was later bred to Ch. Briary Breakthru which produced champions.

It was Lorraine Geter who introduced me to the Labrador Retriever Club of the Potomac in 1976 and it's been my happy place since. This was an eye opener for me. I couldn't have imagined so many beautiful Labradors in one place. I met so many wonderful people and still have longtime friendships.

I have never thought that I would have a Labrador good enough to compete at the LRCP Specialty. In 1989, I showed 'Jill' (BISS Am. Can. Ch. Shadowvale's Jill at Ranbourne). She was awarded WB & BOW under Dot Gartner and Joan McCann. I can't tell you what an honour that was for me.

IN 1980 my husband and I transferred our Kennel name Labradale over to him. In 1982, I registered my new kennel name Ranbourne with the CKC. I acquired my foundation bitch from Mike & Hugette Beattie (Shadowvale). She was bred to AM. Can. Bda. Ch. Bradking Rangeways Mr Chips who produced BISS Can. Ch. Ranbourne This Bud's For You; who has produced Champions in Canada and the US. Bud was awarded BOS in Sweepstakes at the LRCP under Sally Bell. Bud and his little sister Beanie gave me so much joy and lived until the ripe age of 15 ½ years old. This has been a 49+ years journey for me. There have been good times and some not so good, but I would do it all over again. I have made many friendships that I would be proud to call family. I have finished dogs in Canada and the US. I have attended several Specialties over the years and had to cut down at one point, but still kept my feet in the Dog World and enjoyed showing dogs for my Labrador Breeder friends. I knew that I probably would never be a Big Breeder but I am proud of the dogs that I had. In 2004, I decided to apply for my Judge's License which gave me the opportunity to judge the Breed that I love and it is also a way to give back to what gave me such wonderful memories. I later applied to judge Golden Retrievers.

Two special boys to remember are: -

A.J. (black) aka OTCH Nycoma Way Design For Ranbourne, AM. UD, WC, CGC (AM. Ch. Ghoststone Hyspire Dressed to Impress x Nycoma Way Sweet Pea, JH). A.J. passed away a few years ago at the

age to 13 years old and Time (yellow) aka Can. Ch. Belgairn Time in a Bottle at Ranbourne Am. & Can. CDX (Ch. Blackwing Superfine x Ch. Belgarin Shadowbrook Dream Time) who passed in 2022 at the age of 13, bred by the Kelly & Silva families (Belgairn & Shadowbrook).

Howie (black) 10 years old, Ranbourne The Beat Goes On, AM. & Can. CD, Can. CDX is now training in Utility (Can. Ch. Chablais Victoria, WC x GCH. Laurglan Ardent Rogue at Hyspire).

During our Covid period were fortunate to acquire a puppy from Heather Johnson (Nycoma Way), a black boy Can. Ch. Nycoma Way Due North to Ranbourne (GCHB. Ch. Lakeside Memoir of Gallivant, CGC TKN x Nycoma Way Dragonfly on my Shoulder). He is 2 years old and working in Obedience.

I am a lifetime member of the Canadian Kennel Club, The Chateaugay Valley All Breed/Obedience Club, The Labrador Club of Canada Inc. and the Club du Labrador du Quebec. I am also a member of the Canadian Dog Judge's Association. I love ring stewarding both in Conformation and Obedience. It's always an honour and a privilege to be invited to judge a Specialty. I would like to thank the Prairie Labrador Retriever Club for inviting me to judge their Specialty and look forward to seeing some beautiful Labradors.

CLASSIFICATIONS

REGULAR CLASSES

The following CKC classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

JUNIOR PUPPY	Dogs between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show.
SENIOR PUPPY	Dogs between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show.
12 – 15 MONTHS	Dogs between 12 months and under 15 months on day of show.
15 – 18 MONTHS	Dogs between 15 months and under 18 months on day of show.
CANADIAN BRED	Dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country are excluded.
BRED BY EXHIBITOR	Dogs must be <u>owned and handled in the ring by the breeder</u> for this class, but the breeder need not handle the dog for further awards.
OPEN CLASS	For all dogs.
VETERAN CLASS	For all dogs over 7 years of age or older on day of show. These dogs will compete for regular placements and the winner of this class will go on to compete for Best of Breed (they do not compete for Winners). Dogs in this class may be spayed or neutered.
SPECIALS ONLY	Dogs who are Canadian Champions. A CKC Registration Number or ERN must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Dogs entered in any Non-Regular or Unofficial class must also be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only. Spayed or neutered dogs may compete in Non-Regular or Unofficial classes.

EXHIBITION ONLY	Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in this premium list.
EXHIBITION ONLY (4 – 6 MOS.)	Puppies 4-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only 4-6 Months provided the owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. <u>These puppies may not participate in any regular, non-regular or unofficial class or parade, but they may compete in Sweepstakes.</u>
BABY PUPPY	Dogs between 4 months and under 6 months on day of show. These puppies are not eligible to compete for championship points, but they may compete in Sweepstakes. Entry in Exhibition Only 4-6 mos. is not required. NO TCN Fee is payable on this class.
STUD DOG & GET	Stud Dog and two or more of his get. Stud Dog and all Get must also be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only.
BROOD BITCH & PROGENY	Brood Bitch and two or more of her Progeny. Brood Bitch and all Progeny must also be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only.
BRACE	TWO dogs of one breed (either sex or mixed) not necessarily owned by the same owner. Each dog must also be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only.

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

Dogs entered in any Non-Regular or Unofficial class must also be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only. Spayed / neutered dogs may compete in Non-Regular or Unofficial classes.

GUN DOG	For all Labradors who have earned a Certificate of Merit or better at a Licensed Field Trial, or who have received a Junior Hunter Title or higher, a Working Certificate or higher, in Canada or the United States by the close of entries. Each dog must also be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only.

JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES

Entry in Juvenile Sweepstakes from the Exhibition Only class is **not** allowed - **EXCEPT for puppies aged 4-6 months. These puppies may enter from the Baby Puppy class or from the Exhibition Only (4-6 mos.) class.**

The following classes will be offered (divided by sex):

4 – 6 months 6 – 9 months 9 – 12 months 12 – 15 months 15 – 18 months

75% of the total entry fees from each class will be divided as follows:

1st in Class: Rosette and 25% of Class entry fees

2nd in Class: Ribbon and 20% of Class entry fees

3rd in Class: Ribbon and 10% of Class entry fees

4th in Class: Ribbon and 5% of Class entry fees

A rosette and 10% will be offered for Best in Sweepstakes

A rosette and 5% will be offered for Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

All dogs entered in Veteran Sweepstakes must also be entered in a regular class or for Exhibition Only in this show at the appropriate entry fee. **NOTE:** Dogs may be spayed or neutered. The following classes will be offered (divided by sex):

7 – 9 years

9 – 12 years

12 years & older

75% of the entry fees from each class will be divided as follows:

1st in Class: Rosette and 25% of Class entry fees

2nd in Class: Ribbon and 20% of Class entry fees

3rd in Class: Ribbon and 10% of Class entry fees

4th in Class: Ribbon and 5% of Class entry fees

A rosette and 10% will be offered for Best in Sweepstakes

A rosette and 5% will be offered for Best of Opposite Sex

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Conformation Show Rules and Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club.
2. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by C.K.C. rules. All rules and regulations as outlined in the Alberta Kennel Club premium list will also apply to this specialty.
3. Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the show secretary.
4. It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. – CKC rule book, Section 19.7.
5. No dog may be brought on the grounds or premises of an event if it:
 - Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable diseases;
 - Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable diseases within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
 - Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable diseases.

CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

* includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall **not** be included in the calculation for championship points.

If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Breed at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total.

If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing in Specials Only shall be included in the total.

If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total.

If a dog is awarded Winners only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total.

The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section.

Clarification:

Example of directly or indirectly defeating: If the Winners Bitch is awarded Best of Opposite Sex but not Best of Winners, the Best of Winners Dog shall be deemed to have indirectly defeated the Specials bitches, and is thus entitled to add them to the number of dogs and bitches defeated.

In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed that also places in the regular group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the group level.

A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.

Permission shall be granted a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group.

A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must:

- a) Earn at least 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges;
- b) Be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN);
- c) Have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

The Board interprets the words “earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges” to mean:

- a) Three (3) or more Winners awards at not less than three (3) different shows, under three (3) different judges at the breed level;
- b) Each of the three (3) judge’s awards must be one or more championship points won at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing;
- c) All points required for championship status may be earned at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Breed or group placing.

GRAND CHAMPION (GCh)

The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship.

Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship.

To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

- a) Grand Champion Point System - Points towards the Grand Champion title, are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level for all levels of GCh:

- c) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.
- d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

GRAND CHAMPION BRONZE (GChB)

The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.
- c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

GRAND CHAMPION SILVER (GChS)

The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

GRAND CHAMPION GOLD (GChG)

The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

GRAND CHAMPION EXCELLENT (GChEx)

The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website.

To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special:

- a) One (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed)
- b) Three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty best of breed wins.
- c) A CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles.

Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career.

NOTE:

- 1. Exhibitors are required to complete the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet form located on the CKC website and forward to CKC upon completion of requirements above.
- 2. Grandfathering of the previous version of the Grand Champion Excellent title will be honoured up until December 31, 2022.
