No post-dated cheques will be accepted.
Overpayment of entry fees will be considered a donation to the club. Tendering of an NSF cheque shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by the Canadian Kennel Club. A fee of $\$ 25.00$ will be charged for any returned cheque.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to inconsistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". The banks will not clear them. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation are appreciated.

## NOTICE TO ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS - ERN NUMBERS

All foreign born and foreign owned dogs who enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events do not require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN (Event Registration Number). To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/Mastercard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of ERN to you. The cost is $\$ 64.07$. Dog may initially be entered as listed but the ERN must be applied for within 30 days of winning CKC points, awards, or scores to avoid cancellation. ## GENERAL INFORMATION

- ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made. Overpayments will not be refunded.
- ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED WHEN A BITCH ENTERED IN OBEDIENCE COMES INTO SEASON after entry of the bitch has been submitted if a Veterinarian's certificate, (certifying that the bitch was in season within the ten-day period preceding the trial), is delivered to the Trial Secretary on or before the date of the trial.
- Entries must be typewritten or clearly printed. Owners are responsible for errors on entry forms. Cal K-9 Obedience Club of Calgary does not assume any responsibility for incorrect information or errors due to illegibility of information on any entry form.
- Make cheques payable to Cal K- 9 Obedience Club of Calgary. No post-dated cheques will be accepted.
- ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED AFTER CLOSING DATE. Receipts and judging schedule will be emailed. Please ensure email address is printed on your entry form. Armband numbers will be available one hour before the trials begin. There will be NO hard copy catalogues available at the show. The same will be posted on www.dogshow.ca for download by the participants the day of the trial. Please bear in the mind that it will be contingent on internet access for the trial secretary the morning of the trial if the same can be posted 1.5 hours prior to the trial. Otherwise, the same will be posted when the trial secretary has internet.
- (Chapter 3, Section 3.6.1 CKC Obedience Trial Rules \& Regulations). "A judge officiating at a trial held under these Rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the trial. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the trial to see that this rule is effectively carried out."
- ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES. If not in competition, the dog must wear a collar and be on a leash a maximum length of six (6) feet or appropriately confined in the benching area.
- Dogs must be exercised in designated areas ONLY.
- All empty rings are to be kept free of dogs.
- An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry. This Notice of Withdrawal must be in writing and received by the Show Secretary on or before the official closing date and time as published in the Premium List.
- All Miscellaneous Class Dogs who do not have a Certification Number can only compete at the Novice level in Obedience Trials and must pay a listing fee of $\$ 10.50$. Those dogs with a certification number may proceed through all levels. Titles will only be awarded to those dogs that have been certified.
- In Transit permits will be available from the trial secretary if needed. Dogs not entered in the trials in the regular classes or exhibition only will not be permitted in the building without an In Transit Permit.
- Performance Event Number (PEN) allows an unregisterable dog of a CKC recognized breed to participate in competitive events that are appropriate for the breed. For more information regarding applying for a PEN visit www.ckc.ca.
- Cal K-9 Obedience Club of Calgary, its members and volunteers will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, BUT will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- The Trial Superintendent has the authority to expel any dogs deemed to be a danger to other dogs or people. There will be no refund for dogs that are expelled.

WE WILL HAVE SPOTS FOR BENCHING INSIDE. YOU ARE WELCOME TO BENCH IN YOUR VEHICLE WITH YOUR DOG ENSURING THE SAFETY AND COMFORT OF YOUR DOG AT ALL TIMES IN YOUR VEHICLE IF INCLEMENT WEATHER ETC. IF YOU ARE BENCHING INSIDE, PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOUR DOG IS QUIET. ANY EXCESSIVE BARKING AND/OR DISRUPTION BY YOUR DOG, YOU WILL BE ASKED TO REMOVE YOUR DOG TO YOUR VEHICLE.

## OFFICIAL CLASSES

Pre Novice - This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has not earned the title of P.C.D (Pre-Companion Dog). Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class and must have an additional handler for each dog when they are judged together in the Group Exercise. A dog that has earned the title of C.D. is not eligible for this class. This class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to advance to the Novice Classes.
Novice A - This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has not earned the title of C.D. (Companion Dog). Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The dog must be handled by the owner or a member of his immediate family. No person who has previously trained or exhibited a dog through its C.D.X. (Companion Dog Excellent) title shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class.
Novice B - This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has not earned the title of C.D. (Companion Dog). Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the group exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Novice A and Novice B class at any one trial.
Novice C - This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D., C.D.X., U.D., or any Obedience Trial Championship Title prior to the closing date of the trial in which it is to be entered. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the group exercises. Dogs may compete in the Novice C class indefinitely. Scores earned by dog in the Novice C Class are not eligible for High in Trial and do not qualify a dog for any title.
Novice Intermediate - This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D., C.D.X., U.D., or any Obedience Trial Championship. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High in Trial. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. This class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter the Open classes.
Open HA / 18A - This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D. but has not earned the title of C.D.X. (Companion Dog Excellent). Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The dog must be handled by the owner or a member of his immediate family. Any person who has previously trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a U.D. title may not handle a dog in this class.
Open HB / 18B - This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D. in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the group exercises. No dog may be entered in both Open $\mathrm{HA} / 18 \mathrm{~A}$ and Open $\mathrm{HB} / 18 \mathrm{~B}$ at any one trial. A dog that has earned the title of C.D.X. must compete in Open B. Dogs eligible for entry in the Utility Class are also eligible for entry in this class.
Utility A - This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed that has earned the title of C.D.X., but has not earned the title of U.D. The dog must be handled by the owner or a member of his immediate family. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.C.H title may not handle dogs in this class. Handlers may enter more than one dog in this class.

Utility B - This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed that has earned the title of C.D.X. or U.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Utility A and Utility B at the same trial.

## Cal K-9 Obedience Club of Calgary/Kayenna Training Academy Requirements

## General Required Practices

1. At publication time for this premium there are no Federal, Provincial, Local or facility guidelines or restrictions. If things should change prior to the trial dates, Cal K-9 reserves the right to provide those restrictions as they become available.
2. Benching - indoors in the specified areas. You may bench your dogs in your vehicle if you wish ensuring you bring proper shade, ventilation, heat and water for your dogs. Dogs in vehicles will be monitored and dealt with appropriately if they are deemed to be in distress. If benching indoors, your dog must be quiet and not disrupting dogs competing in the ring.
3. Exhibitor parking will be in the paved lot in front of the facility. Please be aware of the reserved parking stalls for the church. We have permission to use the Cal Alta Glass stalls. You may also park at the back of the facility but must enter through the front of the facility and not the back door or side door.

## Information applicable to all participants:

1. The trial will be limited, if necessary, to whatever the current provincial outdoor gathering limits will be at the time of the trial. The limit will apply to entrants, judges, Cal K-9 members and all persons present (including spouse, significant other, family members).
2. Score sheets will be handed out at the end of each class.
3. Ribbons and prizes will be handed out at the completion of each class.
