E-transfers are not accepted by the event secretary. ENTRY FORMS and ONLINE PAYMENT THROUGH Dogshow.ca NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT PAYMENT IN FULL. Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of entry fees will be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by CKC disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. The owner of a dog entered in this Trial is entirely responsible for any error in the entering of his dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made

DAY OF TRIAL ENTRIES

Day of trial entries will be accepted as space allows and must be submitted prior to the judges briefing. Day of entries shall be \$40.00 per component and only cash will be accepted on the day of the trial. Move ups within the same trial ex: Novice to Open is not permitted. A prize and ribbon are not guaranteed for day of entries, however any ribbons earned will be sent out post-trial if required

Indignities to a Judge

3.6.1 A judge officiating at an event held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the event. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the event to see that this rule is effectively carried out

Entry Requirements

Purebred and Mixed-breed dogs

6.1.1 Every dog entered in an approved event or sanctioned match must be one of the following: (a) Registered with the CKC, (b) Have an Event Registration Number (ERN), (c) Have a Performance Event Number (PEN), (d) Eligible for registration with the CKC, and have, a Temporary Competition Number (TCN), (e) Have a Miscellaneous Certification Number, (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed, (f) Have a Canine Companion Number (CCN)

6.1.2 To be eligible to compete at approved trials or sanctioned matches a dog must meet the requirements of Section 6.1.1, and: (a) dog must be at least 6 months of age. (b) May be spayed, neutered, or debarked. (c) Must not be lame (it is the judge's responsibility to determine whether a dog is lame). (d) Must not compete if it has tape or bandages that may impair its working ability (such a dog must be immediately excused and under no circumstances may it be returned later for judging after the tape or bandages have been removed).

6.1.3 If a dog is not registered individually in the records of the CKC, it may be entered at a trial held under these rules with a Temporary Competition Number, provided that: (a) If born in Canada, it is eligible for individual CKC registration (b) If not born in Canada it is eligible for individual registration in the records of the CKC (c) If it is a foreign born and owned dog, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first trial entered (d) The entry of a dog with a Temporary Competition Number at a Scent Detection event held under these rules (sanctioned matches excluded), must be accompanied by the appropriate Temporary Competition fees. Breeds of dogs on the miscellaneous list may not be entered using a Temporary Competition Number, but must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN). Mixed breeds and unrecognized breeds also may not be entered using a Temporary Competition Number (TCN) but must have a Canine Companion Number (CCN).

HANDLERS WITH MULTIPLE DOGS

Handlers with multiple dogs will not be permitted to enter more than one dog in the same class / components. I.e.: Two novice dogs handled by the same person cannot be entered in the same Novice components at the same trial. The handler may enter one dog in Instinct, and one dog in Novice as an alternative.

Bitches in Season

Will be permitted – please see new rule below 2024

6.5.1 Bitches in season are permitted to compete at the discretion of the host club. If the host club allows bitches in season to compete, they must be run at the end of the run order for each class and must wear clean, properly fitted panties.

6.5.2 When a bitch comes into season after entries have closed, the owner of the dog must inform the host club. If bitches in season are not permitted to compete by the host club, the host club must refund the entry fee and the fee for the Temporary Competition Number providing the event secretary receives, on or before the date of the event, a veterinarian's certificate declaring that the bitch was in season within the ten (10) day period preceding the trial. If bitches in season are permitted to compete by the host club, the moved to the end of all run orders for any class they are entered in <u>Trial Venue & Precincts</u>

Trial Venue & Precincts

6.7.2 Only dogs entered in official classes are permitted within the precincts of the trial. 6.7.4 No dog entered in the event will be allowed off leash unless it is in the designated search area being judged according to the rules and regulations.

Moving Up

6.9.1 A dog that is registered in the records of the CKC with an eligible number according to these rules and has fulfilled the requirements for a title in accordance with these rules may be moved to the next level of competition if the schedule permits. The transfer must be on the appropriate move-up form and submitted to the trial secretary by the owner or handler at least 15 minutes before the start of the class.

Please note: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone, but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.
