15.1 Champions and Championship Points

15.1.1. A dog awarded Winners at a Championship Show held under these Rules shall be accredited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 - 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be included in the calculation for championship points.

- 15.1.3 If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Breed at the show, then all dogs competing is the bred, including Specials only, shall be included in the total.
- 15.1.4 If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total.
- 15.1.5 If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total.
- 15.1.6 If a dog is awarded Winners only, then all dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total.
- 15.1.7 The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determines by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section.
- 15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must:
- (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 different judges; and
- (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN)
- (c) Have earned at least one 2 point win, either at the breed or group level.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the **Portage Kennel Club premium list**, will also apply to the specialty.
- Entries will be acknowledges after entry closing, with receipt and judging schedules. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
- 3. Due to limited grooming space NO private x-pens will be allowed.

ACCOMODATIONS & CAMPING & INDOOR POWER

Please see the Portage Kennel Club premium list for Hotels, Motels and for on site Camping as well as information on indoor power for grooming.

New as of March 2, 2020 Temporary Competition Numbers or (TCN) A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event and the same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a (Performance Event Number) PEN or (Canine Companion Number) CCN. While there is no fee to obtain a TCN, exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called listing fees) when entering events using this number. The process of obtaining a TCN will be self-serve; exhibitors will be directed to the CKC website to complete an online application and a TCN will be issued instantly upon completion. Exhibitors may also obtain a TCN by completing a printed application and submitting it to the CKC via mail, or by contacting the Shows and Trials Division by telephone. Until March 2, 2020 dogs may still be entered into CKC events without a registration number or ERN by marking "TCN" on the entry form (or "Listed" if it is an old entry form). However, an e-mail address will be required. Before you apply for a TCN online, exhibitors are encouraged to check their dog's profiles to determine if CKC has already created a TCN for them. There will be a tab for TCN Dogs on the Owner's Portal account. Please note that if your dog does not have a registration number or ERN, and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, scores, or awards, there is no need to apply for a TCN. CKC records will be updated accordingly.
