A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. Further, this rule also includes a club official, volunteer, or any participant at our events.

A service charge of 10% will be assessed by DogShow.ca. This includes entries sent online, by fax, or post using a credit card, Interac or ApplePay for payment. PLEASE NOTE: A service charge of 10% assessed by DogShow.ca for any entries submitted online using credit card or Interac. All fees must accompany your entries. No entries will be accepted without accompanying full payment. Tendering of an N.S.F. cheque or credit cards that have maxed out shall be considered an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by the Canadian Kennel Club

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in U.S. funds it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" as they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and co-operation is appreciated.

Classes Offered

Regular Conformation Classes	
Junior Puppy	A dog between 6 months and under 9 months on the day of the show
Senior Puppy	A dog between 9 months and under 12 months on the day of the show
12-18 Months	A dog between 12 months and under 18 months on the day of the show
Canadian Bred	A dog which is born in Canada
Bred by Exhibitor	A dog(s) owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/handler must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for future awards.
Open	For all dogs.
Veterans (Specialty Show)	Dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs in this class may be spayed or neutered.
Field Class (Specialty Show)	Dogs in this class must have attained a title or placement in a field trial or test (Herding). This class is judged prior to Best of Breed judging with the winners of each sex competing for Best of Breed. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.
Specials Only	For dogs who are Canadian Champions only.
Exhibition Only	Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in the premium list on payment of the prescribed Exhibition Only fees stated in the premium list.
Non-regular Classes	
Baby Puppy	A dog between 3 months and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. Winners of this class do not compete for points. The class is judged after the judging, after Group judging and prior to Best in Show judging.
Altered	This class shall be for any spayed or neutered dogs over the age of 6 months of age
Stud and Get	This class shall be comprised of the stud dog and 2 or more of his get. Ownership in this class need not be identical. The stud dog may be spayed or neutered and must be entered in a Regular class or in Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular class
Dam and Progeny	This class shall be comprised of the dam and 2 or more of her progeny. Ownership in this class need not be identical. The dam may be spayed or neutered and must be entered in a Regular class or in Exhibition Only. Progeny must be entered in a Regular class
Brace	This class shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex). A brace should be judged as an identical pair – same colour, size, gait, and same stride. When viewed from the side they should appear as one dog and its shadow. A Brace must be handled by 1 person on 1 lead
Award of Merit	This award will be made after the Best of Breed judging. A specialty club may offer one Award of Merit for every 10 dogs competing at the Best of Breed level. Where Award of Merit are offered, these awards are made by the judge after the awarding of Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Winners, Select Dog and Select Female. From the remaining dogs in the ring.

Obedience and Rally Obedience

Sweepstakes

Juvenile Sweepstakes – Judge – Ms Daria Coneghan

Juvenile Sweepstakes is open to all puppies six months and under 18 months of age regardless of place of birth. All dogs must be entered in one of the regular official classes on the same day or for exhibition only on the same day. Dogs will be judged in one of the following six classes (divided by sex):

Junior Puppy – 6 months and under 9 months

Senior Puppy – 9 months and under 12 months

Juvenile Puppy – 12 months and under 18 months

For the final judging the first place puppy from each of the classes will be brought together for the final judging of Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes.

Best in Sweepstakes – Rosette and 15% of the total fees collected for the Juvenile Sweepstakes

Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes - Rosette and 10% of the total fees collected for the Juvenile Sweepstakes

1st in each class – Rosette and 50% of total class entry collected

2nd thru 4th in each class – Rosette

25% of fees will be retained by the club to defray costs.

Veteran Sweepstakes – Judge – Ms Daria Coneghan

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all dogs 7 years of age and over and entered in a regular class or for exhibition only on the same day. Spayed and neutered dogs may compete provided they are also entered in exhibition only. Dogs to be judged in one of the following four classes (divided by sex):

Junior Veteran – 7 years and under 10 years

Senior Veteran – 10 years and older

For the final judging the first place winner from each of the classes will be brought together for the final judging of Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes.

Best in Sweepstakes – Rosette and 15% of the total fees collected for the Veteran Sweepstakes

Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes - Rosette and 10% of the total fees collected for the Veteran Sweepstakes

1st in each class – Rosette and 50% of total class entry collected

2nd thru 4th in each class – Rosette

25% of fees will be retained by the club to defray costs.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Competing*	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall **NOT** be included in the calculation for championship points. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF BREED at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF WINNERS, then all dogs defeated directly, or indirectly, in the breed shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included the total. The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per Section 15.1. In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded WINNERS, which also places in the regular Group competition, shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

A dog awarded WINNERS which also places BEST IN SHOW at an All-Breed Championship Show shall be credited with 5 Championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level. In no case can a dog earn more than five points at a single show.

An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour BEFORE the start of the SHOW.

EXTRACTS FROM THE DOG SHOW RULES

CHAPTER 8 - ENTRIES & ENTRY FEES

8.7.1 Withdrawal of Entries: An Exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry at any time up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone, but either written or electronic notification must be received by the show secretary no later than the official closing date and time as stated in the premium list. If written notification is not received, the dog will remain entered in the show.

8.8.2 Tendering of a dishonoured cheque or declined credit card in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of said entry fee and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

CKC RULES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2018

3.3.1 - Substitute Judge – When a show-giving club is notified prior to the opening of the show that an advertised judge will not be able to fulfill his assignment, permission from the CKC to substitute the judge is required. Exhibitors affected by this change may withdraw their entries up to (1) one hour before the **judging of the breed**, notice of withdrawal must be made in writing. All entry and listing fees for withdrawn dogs shall be refunded. An exhibitor may enter a dog under the replacement judge providing that the dog is entered in one (1) of the regular classes of a show being held at the same venue by the same club and has been assigned a competition number. A new entry, along with accompanying fees, will be accepted by the Show Secretary up to one (1) hour prior to the start of the show.

8.2.5—An error in the age-specified class, date of birth or sex of the dog may be amended on the entry form up to one (1) hour before the start of the show.

8.5.8—In case of a judge change (substitute or overload), an exhibitor may enter a dog under the replacement judge providing that the dog is entered in one of the regular classes of a show being held at the same venue by the same club and has been assigned a competition number. A new entry, along with accompanying fees will be accepted by the Show Secretary up to ONE hour PRIOR to the start of the show (see sections 3.3.1, 3.5.1 ,8.5.4)

8.9.3—When one or more all-breed and/or Specialty shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving of a class dogs to Specials Only must be made a minimum of one (1) hour prior to the scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to Specials Only.

12.4.1 Except for Puppy in Group or Show, an owner or handler shall be subject to disciplinary action for withholding a dog from competition for higher awards for which that dog is eligible. Any dog so withheld or absent will result in the cancellation of all awards won at that show (unless the dog is excused by the Show Superintendent).
